## FGS 2023 All-Star Player/Parent Commitment Form

If selected to the All-Star tournament team, I will produce a copy of a legally issued birth certificate and other necessary paperwork on 5/4 at the team meeting, the day after tryouts or the day I am notified of my placement on the team roster.

2. Player Availability
To be eligible for selection onto the All-Star team, a player must be available for
practices and games. Practices are to begin after the All-Star selection the 2nd
week of May. Games and practices will continue throughout the All-Star
Tournaments until the team is eliminated from Championship play. If there is more than one (1) unexcused absence from a game or practice, the player may be removed from
the team. An excused absence would be a medical or family emergency or an
agreed upon "vacation". If you have a pre-paid vacation please note
accordingly and request approval. This should NOT be the reason for not
registering and playing. All other absences are unexcused unless approved by
the player-coaches coordinator, the coach and the Board.

## 3. Tournament dates and locations

FGS All-Stars may be participating in 3 league sponsored tournaments (possibly 5, if qualified with potentially additional cost or fundraising responsibilities). Your daughter's commitment to these tournaments is a mandatory requirement for participation in All-Stars. The dates selected for the All-Star season are yet to be finalized. However, you should expect to be available for practices and games from 5/8/23 thru 7/30/23 (assumes the team qualifies for State and Regional "Nationals"). A team that does NOT qualify for State would be finished after Districts on 6/18/23. The final selection of

tournaments that teams attend will be discussed with the coach and a final decision by the Board. The final approval is dependent upon the respective tournament director and their availability for the respective age division. Teams may request permission to enter additional tournaments at their own cost.

TOURNAMENT DATES ARE LISTED BELOW. Final tournament dates are subject to change, although unlikely, if tournament directors determine it necessary.
